


## Rainbow Room Newsletter May 27-31st



### Last Week...

Our week of exploring our 5 senses was a hit! On Monday we used our sense of sight to watch Skittles make a rainbow! The kids REALLY loved this one :D. We played Listening Bingo on Tuesday where we listened to different sounds and then put a sticker on the matching picture. We used our sense of smell on Wednesday and talked about which scents we didn't like, and which one was our favorite. On Thursday we used our sense of touch to guess what was in our mystery box. Each child got to feel an object in the box and try to guess what it was before we got to see it. Friday was our tasting day! We had a variety of foods to taste at snack time and they all got to pick which one was their favorite. We learned a 5 senses song (they got really good at singing this one!), read some great books, and most of the kids began to understand what body part goes with each sense, how we use them each day, and that our senses tell us all about the world around us. During different activities we discovered that sometimes we use only a few of our senses, and sometimes we use all of them at once! It was a really fun week that all the kids enjoyed :D.
